

How to set up Google Reader and subscribe to content

1 Open your web browser and go to [Google Reader](http://www.google.com/reader): <http://www.google.com/reader>

Your inbox for the web.
With Google Reader, keeping up with your favorite websites is as easy as checking your email.

Stay up to date.
Google Reader constantly checks your favorite news sites and blogs for new content.

Share with your friends.
Use Google Reader's built-in public page to easily share interesting items with your friends and family.

Use it anywhere, for free.

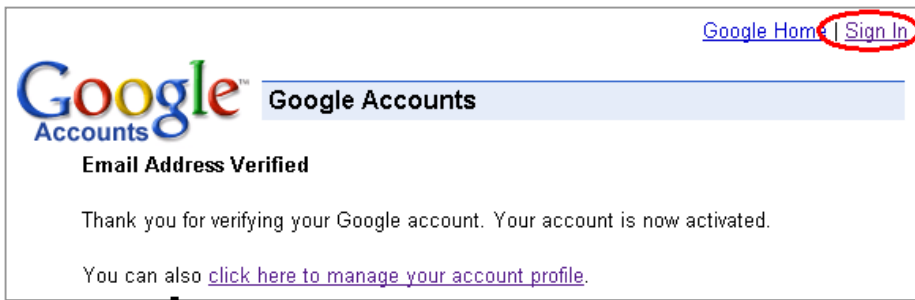

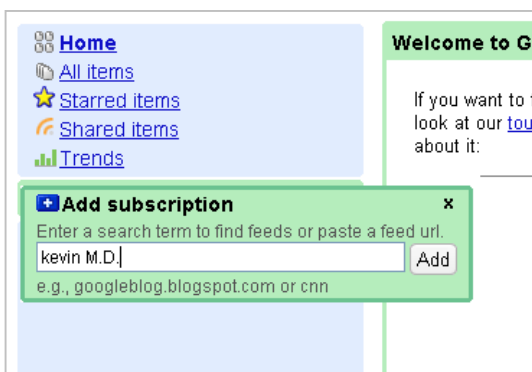
4 Add feeds

You can add feeds through Google and from websites

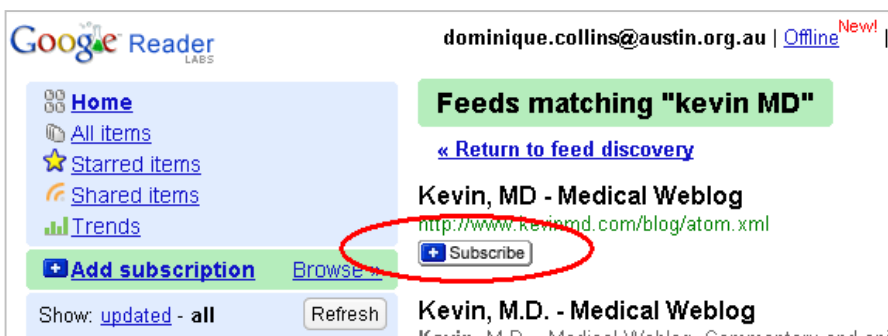
Adding feeds through Google:



Click 'Add subscription'



Type in the name of the site or paste a URL into the search box.



Locate the one you want and click 'Subscribe'

Adding feeds to Google Reader from a website

The appearance of icons and links may vary

Go to the website: in this example: www.medlogs.com



Click the 'Google' link

Click the 'Add to Google Reader' button

If you see an icon like this:



you can subscribe to an RSS feed.

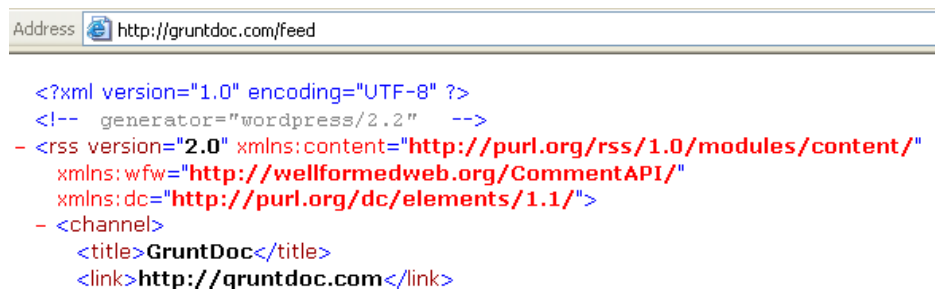
Adding XML feeds

Go to: <http://www.gruntdoc.com/>

Click on the RSS icon

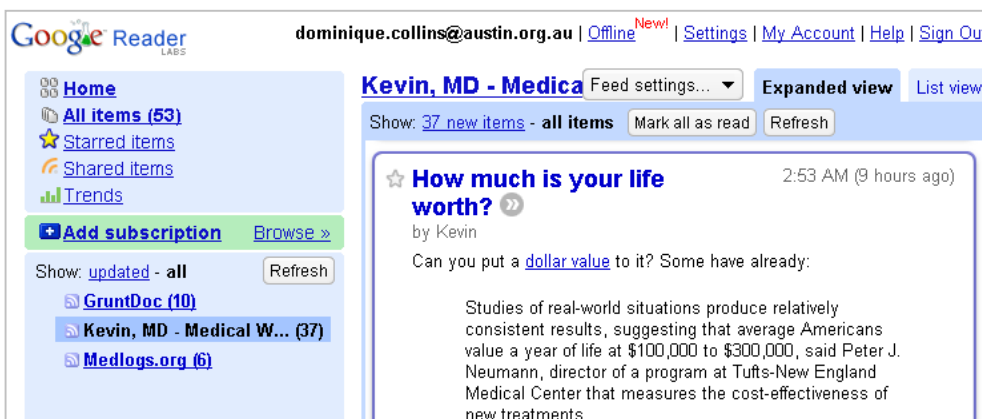


The following will appear:



Copy and paste the URL (<http://gruntdoc.com/feed>) into your Google Reader 'Add subscriptions' box and click 'Add'

5 Use Google Reader



Feeds appear on the right

On the left: bold items and the number show the number of unread items

As you scroll through on the right, the number decreases on the left

Remember to check your feeds regularly. Each time you log in, Google Reader will update with new content.
